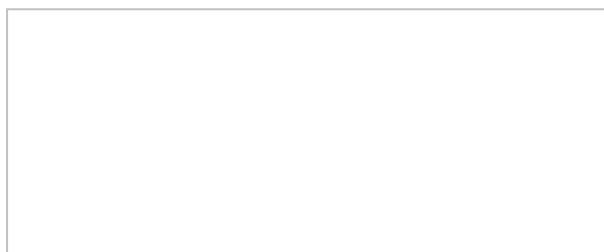

Today we received notice that the petition to decertify the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 114 has been withdrawn by the “guild”. This means there will be no election conducted by the Public Employment Relations Commission (PERC).

This also means that Local 114 continues to be your exclusive bargaining representative and can move forward in negotiating a new collective bargaining agreement that can include a retro-active pay increase effective January 1st of this year.

The Washington State Council of County and City Employees and AFSCME our International Union, will be working together to seek the best possible collective bargaining agreement with the City of Bellingham.
